AKC Code of Sportsmanship

PREFACE: The sport of purebred dog competitive events dates prior to 1884, the year of AKC's birth. Shared values of those involved in the sport include principles of sportsmanship. They are practiced in all sectors of our sport: conformation, performance and companion. Many believe that these principles of sportsmanship are the prime reason why our sport has thrived for over one hundred years. With the belief that it is useful to periodically articulate the fundamentals of our sport, this code is presented.

- Sportsmen respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and vigorous competition, as well as winning and losing with grace.
- Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- \bullet The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- The sportsman respects the AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.
- Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.
- Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those who trade with them.
- Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportsmen spurn any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them.
- Sportsmen always consider as paramount the welfare of their dog.
- Sportsmen refuse to embarrass the sport, the American Kennel Club, or themselves while taking part in the sport.

Neutered dogs and spayed bitches are allowed to compete in Veterans classes at independent specialty shows. Only first place winners of these classes are eligible to advance & compete in Best of Breed competition.

Combined Field Trial Dog and Hunt Dog Classes - Class for dogs and class for bitches who have a placement or a Judge's Award or Merit for an AKC Licensed Field Trial ~or~ must have an AKC Hunting title of JH, SH, or MH. Field Trial exhibitors must have proof of the FT placement of JAM with you on the day of the show. Only the first place winners of these classes are eligible to advance & compete in Best of Breed competition.

Non-Regular Classes Involving Multiple Dog Entries (Saturday AM only) Stud Dog - Class for Dogs with at least two progeny, with judging based solely on the

Stud Dog - Class for Dogs with at least two progeny, with judging based solely on the merits of the get. Stud dog to be examined for disqualifying or excusable faults only.

For Stud Dog, Brood Bitch - All progeny must be entered in any other class in the specialty. Class winners are NOT eligible to advance to the Best of Breed competition just by virtue of having won this class.

Awards of Merit

A maximum of four (4) Judge's Awards of Merit rosettes will be available for presentation by the breed specialty judge to Vizslas they hold in high regard. Vizslas available for these awards shall be selected from the Best of Breed entry, plus Winners and Dog and Winners Bitch, along with the winners of the Veterans and Combined Field Trial/Hunt Dog classes. The Award of Merit winners will be selected after the Best of Breed, Best of Winners. Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, Select Dog and Select Bitch are made. All remaining dogs in competition are eligible for an Award of Merit.

THE AKC NATIONAL OWNER HANDLED SERIES

This is a non-titling competition for dogs that are exhibited by their owners that are not professional handlers. All dogs that are owner-handled and are not solely owned or exhibited by professional handlers* meet the requirements for this competition. Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner- Handled eligible at the time of entry using the check box on the entry form. Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the judge's book, steward's book & the catalog.

Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner*. Professional handlers, household members and assistants to current professional handlers may not exhibit the dog in any breed competition during the entire show. *Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay or received payment for handling a dog within the last five years. Entries into the Amateur-Owner-Handler class are automatically entered into the AKC NOHS and do not have to check the box on the entry form.

 □ A foreign born dog may enter this class if they are registered in the country of origin. □ All entrants are to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinari-
an's protocol.
□ Professional handlers, members of their household and current assistants to profes-
sional handlers may not personally exhibit dogs in the Four-to-Six Month (Beginner Pup- py) Competition. Dogs that are owned or co-owned by the forenamed may compete in
this competition but must be handled by a non-professional handler. Professional han-
dlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers
organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves
as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. Dogs may not be exhibited by current assistants and household members of a professional handler.
☐ Minors (under 18) with amateur status who reside with professional handlers and cur-
rent assistants to professional handlers that are eligible to compete in Junior Showman-



Entry blank MUST be filled out with the necessary information; otherwise the entry in Junior Showmanship will not be accepted.

NOVICE JUNIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE INTERMEDIATE CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE SENIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN JUNIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN INTERMEDIATE CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN SENIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

MASTER CLASS: This class will be for Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and must change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition present or a first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open, after the closing of entries for a show, are required to transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class. Must notify the Superintendent/ Show Secretary prior to the judging of the class at the show.

For kids from 5 & Under 9 years of age (with a parent or guardian)
All dogs must be at least four (4) months of age to be exhibited.
All dogs must wear a proper collar with leash.
Entry Fee is FREE
Entries accepted at Club Table until 30 minutes before ring time.

The Pee Wee Event is for children from the ages of 5 to under 9 years of age. Each Pee Wee class consists of the child and a responsible adult which must be in the ring with the Pee Wee. The dog must be at least 4 months of age and have the proper lead and collar. The responsible adult is responsible for the control of the dog outside the ring. Clubs must provide an additional lead if the mentor inside the ring feels that it is necessary for the safety of the dog and the Pee Wee. A Release of Liability must be completed before the Pee Wee may enter the Pee Wee Event.
