



## VCC Fun Field Day and meeting 2024

It will be held on Sat. Oct 26, 2024 at the beautiful home of Stacie Smith and Windchime Kennel. This is where we hold our hunt test every February.

We will gather, drink coffee and chat from 7 am-7:45. Then start settling for presentation, to start at 8. At 8:30 we will find our way out to the field.

This year we will have a short introduction to the field work prior to starting the individual sessions with each dog so we request that you be there to start on-time. Stacie and John Roland will each work the beginner dogs and puppies so we can do 2 at a time in separate areas. Then the more experienced dogs that need birds shot will be worked with them as a team, one handler and one gunner. Each practice session comes with 2 birds. There may be extras for you to purchase and go off to another area to practice in later.

**Space is limited for field work with the trainer's assistance. Please sign up ahead of time** with number of dogs and level of field work you want to practice at, and/or how many birds.

As always, we will be having lunch and fellowship. Lunch will be sandwiches and assorted condiments😊. Please sign up if you plan to eat and let us know how many people will eat. **You may bring a side dish or dessert to share if you like.** There will be bottled water and assorted soft drinks.

We will have a club meeting during the lunch break Then back out for more field time or socialization.

Lunch will be \$9 per person.

Training with Stacie and John is \$25 per dog and includes 2 birds.

Additional birds at \$5 (subject to change by a small amount) each. Let us know how many birds you would like if more than the initial 2.
